THIS WEEK IN HISTORY: FIRST AIRPLANE FLIGHT : December 17, 1902

Near Kitty Hawk, North Carolina, Orville and Wilbur Wright make the first successful flight in history of a self-propelled, heavier-than-air aircraft. Orville piloted the gasoline-powered, propeller-driven biplane, which stayed aloft for 12 seconds and covered 120 feet on its inaugural flight.

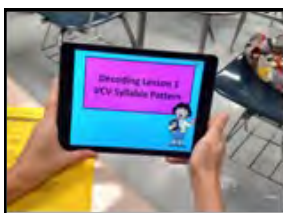
Perfect Attendance Raffle:

District Policy You Should Know

Bulletin 5469.2 Lockdown and Rapid Relocation Procedures for all schools

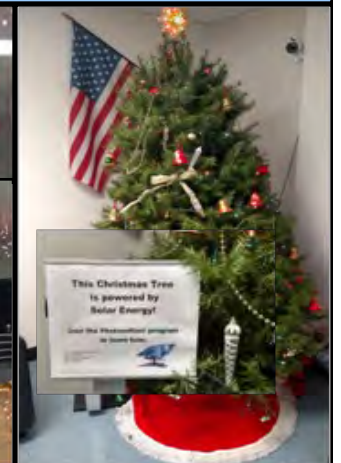
The Los Angeles Unified School District is committed to providing a safe and secure learning environment for its students. When an event on or near a campus occurs that requires the school to initiate a lockdown, school site administrators are to follow the guidelines in this Bulletin. This Bulletin replaces BUL-5469.1 dated February 13, 2013, issued by the Office of the Superintendent, and includes procedures for Rapid Relocation during an "Active Shooter" incident.
