BUL-6460.0 Explosive Device Threats and Suspicious Objects . February 17, 2015

Suspicious Object ... "If a suspicious package or other object is found on or adjacent to campus, the principal should be immediately alerted. The principal will consult with School Police to determine a course of action. The principal will make the appropriate notifications and take other actions...as necessary".
