## THIS WEEK IN HISTORY: February 9, 1942

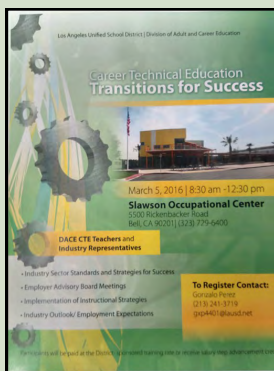
**Daylight saving time instituted:** Congress pushes ahead standard time for the United States by one hour in each time zone, imposing daylight saving time—called at the time “war time.” Daylight saving time, suggested by President Roosevelt, was imposed to conserve fuel, and could be traced back to World War I, when Congress imposed one standard time on the United States to enable the country to better utilize resources, following the European model. The 1918 Standard Time Act was meant to be in effect for only seven months of the year—and was discontinued nationally after the war. It was not until 1966 that Congress passed legislation setting a standard time that permanently superseded local habits.

### CCAE STATE CONFERENCE

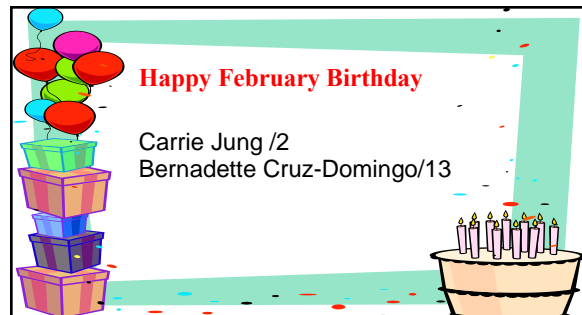


ELASA Staff members interested in attending in the CCAE state Conference **April 21-23** in San Francisco can submit their name for consideration.
