### THIS WEEK IN HISTORY: First Academy Awards: February 18, 1929

The Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences announces the winners of the first Academy. It was a far cry from the Oscars today: Spearheaded by movie mogul Louis B. Mayer, the Academy was organized in May 1927 as a non-profit organization dedicated to the advancement and improvement of the film industry. Though the announcements were made in February 1929, the actual awards weren't given out until May 16, 1929, in a ceremony and banquet held in the Blossom Room of the Hollywood Roosevelt Hotel. Some 270 people attended the dinner, many paying \$5 each for a ticket.

Los Angeles Regional Adult Education  
Consortium funding agreement  
Statement by Superintendent Michelle King

**February 9, 2016** We are very excited that the Los Angeles Regional Adult Education Consortium has accepted a funding agreement that will allow L.A. Unified to receive more than \$15 million to support the District's adult learners. After months of stalled discussions, I negotiated an agreement with Los Angeles Community College Chancellor Francisco C. Rodriguez that will disburse 90 percent of their allocation to L.A. Unified and the four other consortium members. L.A. Unified has the largest adult education program in the nation, and this funding is vital to the nearly 100,000 students who are striving to improve their lives by learning basic educational skills, achieving citizenship or training for a career. This compromise will allow us to continue our important work while the final funding distribution is discussed.

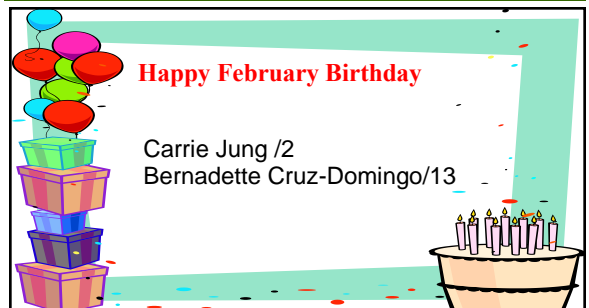

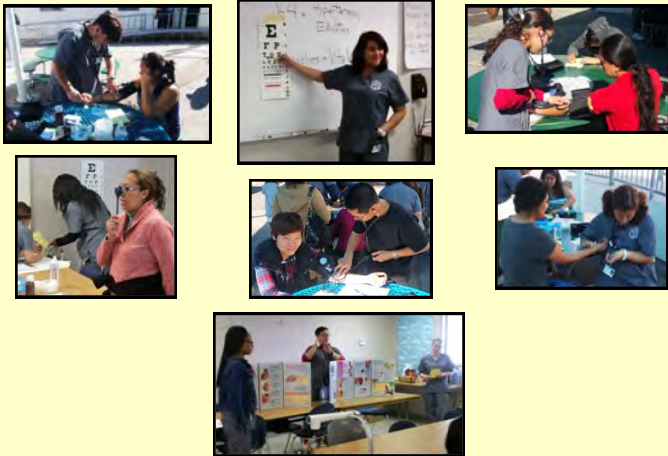

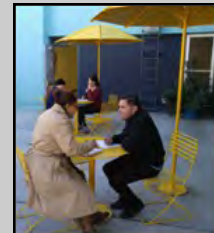
