THIS WEEK IN HISTORY: Cassius Clay: **“Muhammed Ali”** becomes World Champ!

On **February 25, 1964** 22-year-old Cassius Clay shocks the odds-makers by dethroning world heavyweight boxing champ Sonny Liston in a seventh-round technical knockout. Liston, who had twice demolished former champ Floyd Patterson in one round, was an 8-to-1 favorite. However, Clay predicted victory, boasting that he would “float like a butterfly, sting like a bee” and knock out Liston in the eighth round. Muhammad Ali would go on to become one of the 20th century’s greatest sporting figures.

“DACE Safety Week”.



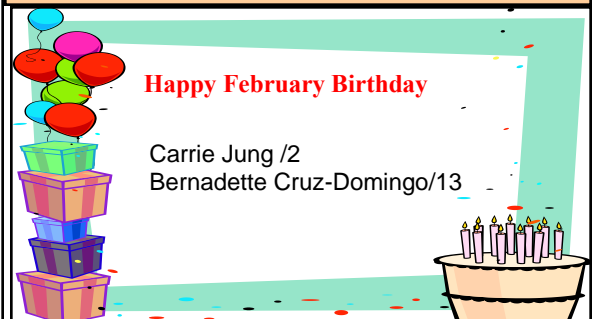
During this week CTE

District Policy You Should Know

California Government Code Section 3100-3109 states in part:

*It is hereby declared that the protection of the health and safety and preservation of the lives and property of the people of the state from the effects of natural, manmade, or war-caused emergencies which result in conditions of disaster or extreme peril to life, property, and resources is of paramount state importance...in protection of its citizens and resources, **all public employees are hereby declared to be disaster service workers...***
