THIS WEEK IN HISTORY: Hattie McDaniel wins Oscar for Gone With The Wind
February 29, 1940 Gone with the Wind is honored with eight Oscars by the American Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences. The movie swept the prestigious Best Picture, Director, Screenplay, Cinematography, Art Direction, Film Editing, and Actress categories. However, the most momentous award that night went to **Hattie McDaniel** for her portrayal of "Mammy," a housemaid and former slave. McDaniel, who won the Best Supporting Actress Award, was the first African American actress or actor ever to be honored with an Oscar.

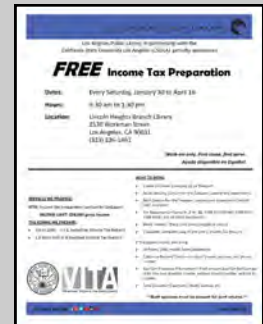

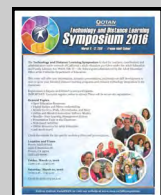
