REFUND POLICY

Career Training courses require fees that often go into the hundreds of dollars. It is vitally important that students are aware of and understand the Division Refund Policy which states: "...a student may be issued a refund of fees when he or she drops the class following the first day of possible attendance or within seven (7) calendar days of the initial enrollment period. However, a \$20 drop fee will be assessed on a per course basis, except when an administrator has closed the class." **After seven days, there will be no refund of class fees.**

ESL TEXTBOOKS

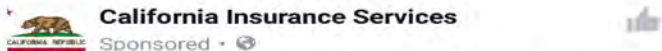

Students who attend 12 or more hours of class per week are eligible for a student bus pass. If you qualify, please speak to your teacher or a counselor to learn how to apply.

SAFETY ALERT

The reuse of disposable water bottles can be an unhealthy practice. The main reason that this is a problem is due to the lack of hygiene. Most single use bottles are very difficult to clean and studies have shown that bacteria levels increase the longer these bottles are used, with or without cleaning. Avoiding the reuse of disposable bottles is also preferable due to the possibility of breakdown of the plastic and leaching of chemical components into the water. It is highly recommended to use water bottles that are specifically designed to be reused. Reusable water bottles come in many different materials, from specially designed plastic to glass to various metals. Please go over this information with students.
