This course presents strategies for planning lessons for learners of widely varying language skills. This course is from March 10 through April 7, 2017.



"LET'S TALK FRIDAY" AT EASTSIDE LEARNING CENTER

The students gathered in groups of 8-10 and topic cards were handed out with category words such as furniture. One student read aloud the topic word and the other students had to take turns saying words associated with the category. If the student couldn't think of a word, then students could say "pass" one time. The objective was for students to come up with associated vocabulary words based on the category word, thus practicing their knowledge and retention of English language vocabulary as well as listening and reading skills. This exercise was quite popular with students, as many expressed it was quite exciting as they waited their turn to say an associated vocabulary word.
