

AC²T Student Accountability System

How Enrollment Status is Tracked

To maintain "Good Standing" in AC²T: Turn in all of your assigned work on time each and every week.

Your goal: ZERO WEEKLY POINTS!

How weekly points are determined:

- All assigned work turned in on time each week = 0.0 Weekly Points
- All assigned work turned in late or not at all = 1.0 Weekly Points
- Excessive Redos (more than 25%) = 1.0 Weekly Points
- Behavior Issues = Teacher's Discretion

Enrollment Status and Point Consequences

WP/0 = Good Standing

WP/1 = Needs Improvement – Student/Teacher conference or possible phone call home.

WP/2 = In Danger of Probation Status – Letter sent home and possible advisor conference.

WP/3 = Immediate Action Needed – Student must improve or will be placed on probation.

Phone call to student and/or parent will be made.

WP/4 = Student placed on INACTIVE STATUS. The student may not turn in any work until a conference is held with the AC²T Advisor. A Parent Conference will be required for minors. In danger of being dropped from the AC²T Program. On probation until the student works down to Zero Points.

If the student is on probation and reaches 4 points and continues to show little/no progress, the AC²T Program is probably not the best educational option for that student. The student should return all books and materials and he/she should seek assistance from the AC²T Advisor for a new placement.

How to return to Good Standing Status or WP/0:

A student who has accumulated any Weekly Points has a weekly opportunity to reduce their points. Turning in the required assigned work each week on time will reduce the Weekly Point total by .25 points until the student has returned to WP/0.
