NURSE ASSISTANT: LONG TERM CARE PROGRAM

Prerequisites:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Pass Assessment Test
 - Reading and Comprehension Level 8.0
 - Math Skill Level Equivalent to Math 7.0
- Current California Identification Card, California Driver's License, a current US Passport., or T.I.N.
- CPR/BLS Certification (Estimated cost \$50)
- Show Original U. S. High School Diploma, the original score sheet for the U. S. GED/HiSET or completion of the 12th grade documentation in a foreign educational system (independent NACES agency approved by LAUSD). If you do not have a HS diploma, please see an advisor.
- Completion of Medical Terminology class
- American Heart Association or BLS Health Care Providers Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- Be able to pass a background check and a physical exam
